**Closures and restrictions**

- On 26 January 2023 the area marked in yellow is closed to vessels from 3pm – 3:15pm, 4pm – 4:15pm, 5pm – 5:15pm, 6pm – 6:15pm, 7pm – 7:15pm and 8pm – 9pm.
- During the above times vessels can't transit through, anchor or moor within the closed water area.
- Swimming is not permitted in the closed water area.
- An 8 knot speed limit will be in place between the Narrows and Causeway bridges including all of Perth Water from 8am on Thursday 26 until sunrise on Friday 27 January 2023.
- There will be a 150metre exclusion zone area around the four fireworks barges from 8am on Thursday 26 until sunrise on Friday 27 January 2023.
- Anchoring is permitted in Perth Water outside of the closed water area and navigable channels.
- Skippers navigating the area should be aware of the available water depth and monitor their radio (27Mhz channel 88 and VHF channels 9 and 16).
- There is a 10-knot speed limit between sunset and sunrise.
