
BARRACKS ARCH



Located on the corner of Malcolm and Elder Streets in the city of Perth, Barracks Arch is a heritage listed monument to the former Barracks built to house the Enrolled Pensioner Force who came to Australia as guards on convict ships.

Barracks Arch is a three story Tudor style building that resembles a medieval castle, and was completed in 1866.
