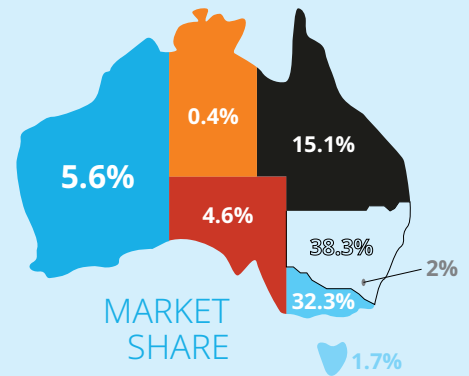

## ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTION
