Recycling & reuse information

Items collected during the verge collection are taken to a sorting facility to ensure as much as possible is recovered and recycled.

Please assess all items for recycling and reuse options before putting them out for collection.

Collection will commence the week beginning

Monday 14 March 2022

Do not place your waste out on the verge until Saturday 12/03/2022 – the weekend before the collection service begins

Items for collection must be placed on the verge before 6am on Monday 14 March

This is the second of two verge collections in the 2021/22 financial year.

Please note the verge collection service is available to residential properties only

To make collection easier, please follow these simple steps

- Separate electronic waste, whitegoods and garden waste into separate piles
- Neatly place items on the street verge
- Trim tree branches/prunings to a maximum length of 1.5m. Larger branches will NOT be removed
- Items should be of a maximum weight that is easily handled by two people
- Use boxes or bags for lawn clippings, cuttings and leaves
- Ensure items do not obstruct the footpath or your normal bin service

WHAT YOU CAN DO with the items we will not remove

Did you know most items not accepted during the bulk verge collection can be taken to:

These items can include (but are not limited to) construction waste (cement, bricks, rubble, sand), tyres, vehicle parts and motor oil.

Note: fees may apply to some items so please contact the facility before you visit for the most up-to-date information.

Garden waste

Tree and shrub prunings up to 1.5m in length and up to 30cm in diameter, lawn clippings & leaves in boxes or bags



Electronic waste

Televisions, computers, printers, mobile phones, DVD & CD Players, VCRs, and Hi-Fi Equipment



Whitegoods

Stoves, freezers, refrigerators, etc



Mattresses



Old Furniture

Please note: Garden waste and mattresses are collected separately to be recycled. Other verge collection items are sent to the recycling sorting facility.

This residential verge collection **WILL NOT REMOVE**



Construction waste

(cement, bricks, rubble, sand)



Foodstuffs and general household waste



Large tree trunks or stumps over 30cm in diameter and tree branches over 1.5m in length



Hazardous waste



Vehicle parts and motor oil



Tyres

DO NOT place any of these items out for collection.

They WILL NOT be removed.

Please note: Verge collection is not available to commercial premises.
